TRUSTEE'S PRELIMINARY REPORT

IN THE MATTER OF THE BANKRUPTCY OF COLOUR TECH MARKETING INC.

Trustee: MNP Ltd.

SECTION A - Background

Colour Tech Marketing Inc. ("**Colour Tech**" or the "**Company**") was incorporated in 1991. It was an owner managed business and operated from leased premises at 17-3620 Larid Road, Mississauga, Ontario. The registered directors of the Company are Robert and Margaret Campbell.

Colour Tech was a printing company specializing in customized mailings, brochures, and business cards. Its customers were primarily real estate agents. Sales have declined in recent years as the real estate industry has shifted away from print to digital advertising media. The Company was hard hit by the impacts of the Covid-19 pandemic and was not able to recover.

Ultimately the company ceased operations and made an assignment in bankruptcy on July 7, 2023. MNP Ltd. was appointed as trustee. (the **"Trustee"**).

CLASS I - Stocks of merchandise

The Company depleted its inventory prior to the bankruptcy.

CLASS II - Plant, machinery, equipment, and office

Binding equipment owned by the Company was sold prior to the bankruptcy and proceeds were deposited to the Company bank account. There were two printing presses subject to lease agreements that will be released to the secured creditor.

CLASS III - Buildings and real estate

The Company did not own real estate.

CLASS IV - Books and records

The Trustee has taken possession of the books and records required to administer the bankruptcy.

CLASS V - Other assets

Accounts receivable totaling \$14,619 were outstanding at the date of bankruptcy. Approximately half of this amount is from invoices outstanding since 2021 and not expected to be collectible. The Trustee is working to collect the remaining accounts.





Property of Bankruptcy not divisible amongst creditors by virtue of Section 67(b), of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act None known.

Property placed under the guardianship of the Company None known.

SECTION B

1. Conservatory and protective measures

The business was shut down prior to bankruptcy. The Trustee has taken no conservatory or protective measures.

The Trustee has written to CIBC and the Bank of Nova Scotia requesting the bank accounts be frozen.

2. Carrying on business

The Company's operations ceased prior to bankruptcy.

SECTION C - Legal proceedings

There are no legal proceedings the Trustee is aware of.

<u>SECTION H - Other matters</u> The Trustee has received a third-party deposit of \$14,000 from Bob Campbell to cover the fees and disbursements of the bankruptcy in the event asset realizations are insufficient.
