

MEMO TO STUDENTS:

McKay Career Training Inc. has filed for bankruptcy and can no longer be registered as a private vocational school within the Province of Saskatchewan. The school's Certificate of Registration has been cancelled and it has ceased operations.

The Ministry of Advanced Education is committed to assisting students by exploring options available to compensate and/or finish the training of all those affected. Those options will be discussed on a student-by-student basis and may depend on several factors:

- Availability and timing of an alternate training program;
- How far along a student is in their program; and
- Individual situation of each student.

Beginning the week of May 29, 2023, ministry officials will reach out to set up appointments with students to discuss the options available.

For students who have a **Canada Saskatchewan Integrated Student Loan**, the following information is available:

- If you have a student loan disbursement scheduled for May 1, you will receive your funding.
- You will receive a discontinuation notice. However, the ministry will adjust overpayment balances so that no overpayments are applied as a result of your current period of study.
- Student loan repayment will not start until 6 months after your period of study. If you start another program of study during this time, you will be able to apply for student aid. Please notify the National Student Loans Service Centre to ensure you do not enter repayment.
- If you enter repayment and are experiencing difficulties repaying your loans, there are repayment options available for you including the Repayment Assistance Plan. Please contact the National Student Loans Service Centre to discuss your repayment options and apply for repayment supports.
- You can contact the Student Service Centre if you have questions about your individual circumstances.
