APPROVAL AND VESTING ORDER

THIS MOTION, made by Commercial Print-Craft, Limited ("CPC") for an Order authorizing CPC to sell its assets and inventory, out of the ordinary course of business, pursuant to section 65.13(1) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (the "BIA") and vesting title to those assets and inventory in the purchaser, free and clear of any security, charge or other restriction, as well as other relief, was heard this day at 80 Dundas Street, London, Ontario.

ON READING the Affidavit of Thomas William Downing, sworn July 24, 2019, the Second Report to the Court of MNP Ltd. as Trustee under the Notice of Intention ("MNP" or the "Trustee") dated July 24, 2019 (the "Second Report"), the Confidential Supplement to the Second Report to the Court of MNP Ltd. as Trustee Under the Notice of Intention dated July 24, 2019 (the "Confidential Supplement") and on reading the consent of the secured creditor, Bank of Montreal, filed, and on hearing the submissions of counsel for CPC, no one else appearing on the Motion although properly served as appears from the Affidavit of Service of Cory Wood sworn July 25, 2019, filed:

- 1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the time for service, filing and confirmation of the Notice of Motion, Motion Record, Second Report and Confidential Supplement be and is hereby abridged such that this Motion is properly returnable today and further service thereof is hereby dispensed with.
- 2. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that CPC be and is hereby authorized to sell all of its assets, including, but not limited to, those assets listed in Schedule A hereto (the "Assets"), out of the ordinary course of business, pursuant to section 65.13 of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (the "BIA") by way of public auction to be conducted by 584919 Ontario Limited cob as Syl-Mar Management ("Syl-Mar") on behalf of CPC (the "Auction").
- 3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that CPC be and is hereby authorized to sell all of its inventory (the "Inventory"), out of the ordinary course of business, pursuant to section 65.13 of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (the "BIA") by way of private sales, as detailed in the Second Report (the "Inventory Sales") or alternatively, if the Inventory Sales cannot be completed for any reason out of the control of CPC, by way of the Auction.
- 4. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that upon payment by the successful purchaser or purchasers (the "Purchaser") of the requisite consideration as agreed upon at the Auction, or as agreed upon for the Inventory Sales, and the provision by Syl-Mar or CPC of a receipt for the payment (the "Receipt"), all of the right, title and interest of CPC in and to the Assets and/or the Inventory shall vest absolutely in the Purchaser, free and clear of and from any and all ownership, security, charge, restriction or other interests (whether contractual, statutory, or otherwise), hypothecs, mortgages, trusts or deemed trusts (whether contractual, statutory, or otherwise), liens, executions, levies, charges, or other financial, ownership or monetary claims, whether or not they have attached or been perfected, registered or filed and whether secured, unsecured or otherwise (collectively, the "Claims") including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing: (i) all charges, security interests or claims evidenced by registrations pursuant to the *Personal Property Security Act* (Ontario) or any other personal property registry system; and (ii) those Claims listed on Schedule B hereto, (all of which are collectively referred

to as the "Encumbrances") and, for greater certainty, this Court orders that all of the Encumbrances affecting or relating to the Assets and the Inventory are hereby expunged and discharged as against the Assets and the Inventory.

5. THIS COURT ORDERS that upon provision of the Receipt, and the payment of the consideration set out therein by the Purchaser, the net proceeds from the sale of the Assets and the Inventory, after proper adjustments and payment of all sale costs (the "Net Proceeds") shall stand in the place and stead of the Assets and the Inventory, and that from and after the provision of the Receipt, all Claims and Encumbrances shall attach to the Net Proceeds with the same priority as they had with respect to the Assets and the Inventory immediately prior to the sale, as if the Assets and the Inventory had not been sold and remained in the possession or control of the person having that possession or control immediately prior to the sale.

6. THIS COURT ORDERS that, notwithstanding:

- (a) the pendency of these proceedings;
- (b) any applications for a bankruptcy order now or hereafter issued pursuant to the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (Canada) in respect of CPC and any bankruptcy order issued pursuant to any such applications; and
- (c) any assignment in bankruptcy made in respect of CPC;

the vesting of the Assets and the Inventory in the Purchaser pursuant to this Order shall be binding on any trustee in bankruptcy that may be appointed in respect of CPC and shall not be void or voidable by creditors of CPC, nor shall it constitute nor be deemed to be a fraudulent preference, assignment, fraudulent conveyance, transfer at undervalue, or other reviewable transaction under the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (Canada) or any other applicable federal or provincial legislation, nor shall it constitute oppressive or unfairly prejudicial conduct pursuant to any applicable federal or provincial legislation.

- 7. THIS COURT ORDERS that the Confidential Supplement, filed with the Court separate and apart from the Second Report, shall hereafter be filed in the within Court File in a sealed envelope or other appropriately sealed container and that only the Court and its clerk shall be entitled to open and review the contents without a further Order of the Court. The sealed envelope or container shall be endorsed with the title of proceedings in this action and a label identifying the contents as being "The Confidential Supplement to the Second Report to the Court of MNP Ltd., in its capacity as Trustee under the Notice of Intention dated June 11, 2019", and the words "SUBJECT TO PROTECTIVE ORDER" and a statement in the following form: "THIS ENVELOPE IS NOT TO BE OPENED EXCEPT BY THE COURT OR ITS CLERKS OR BY OTHER PERSONS BY ORDER OF THE COURT".
- 8. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the sealing of the Confidential Supplement shall continue until the passage of ninety (90) days for the date of the within Order or the completion of the sales pursuant to the within Approval and Vesting Order dated August 2, 2019, whichever is earlier.
- 9. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that CPC be and is hereby granted a further extension of forty-five days in order to file a Proposal such that a Proposal must be filed, or a further extension of time obtained, on or before October 10, 2019.
