THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES as follows:

1. The time limited for FHC Enterprises Ltd. to file a proposal as required by section 50.4(8) and 62(1) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* be extended to May 21, 2020, pursuant to section 50.4(9) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*.
2. The Trustee is authorized to pay to itself \$57,807.00 plus G.S.T. out of trust on account of its fees and disbursements, subject to a final taxation of its accounts.
3. Any party who did not receive notice of this application may apply to set aside this order on two days' notice to the solicitors for FHC Enterprises Ltd.


