Remedy Claimed or Sought:

- 1. The Applicant, Vertex Downhole Ltd. ("Vertex" or the "Applicant") respectfully seeks an Order substantially in the form attached hereto as Schedule "A" (the "Extension Order"):
 - (a) if necessary, abridging the time for service of this Application and the supporting materials and deeming service thereof to be good and sufficient;
 - (b) pursuant to section 50.4 of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (the "*BIA*"), extending the period of time within which Vertex is required to file a proposal to its creditors (the "**Proposal Period**") by 45 days up to and including July 14, 2022 (the "**Third Stay Extension**"); and
 - (c) such further and other relief as may be sought by Vertex and this Honourable Court may deem appropriate.

Grounds for Making this Application:

- 2. On February 4, 2022, Vertex commenced the within proceedings (the "**NOI Proceedings**") by filing a Notice of Intention to Make a Proposal (the "**NOI**") pursuant to section 50.4(1) of the *BIA* with the Office of the Superintendent of Bankruptcy.
- 3. Vertex is a Canadian Controlled Private Corporation, incorporated pursuant to the laws of the Province of Alberta with its registered office located in Calgary, Alberta. Vertex is widely held by seventy-five different shareholders, made up of institutional investors, individuals, family trusts, current and former employees. The largest single shareholder owns 11% of the issued and outstanding shares.
- 4. In turn, Vertex is the sole shareholder of:

- (a) HPC Energy Services Holdings (USA) Inc., a Delaware corporation; which is the sole shareholder of:
- (b) HPC Energy Services Subsidiary (USA) Inc., a Delaware corporation; which is the sole shareholder of
- (c) Vertex Downhole Inc; a Delaware corporation ("Vertex US"),(collectively, the "Vertex Group").
- 5. The Vertex Group is comprised of integrated oil and gas service companies with a product base uniquely designed to support downhole drilling.
- 6. HSBC Bank of Canada ("**HSBC**") is Vertex's senior-secured creditor.
- 7. MNP Ltd. is the proposal trustee of Vertex (in such capacity, the "**Proposal Trustee**").

Extension of the Proposal Period

- 8. Vertex requires the Third Stay Extension to continue the restructuring of its business and affairs, to work towards making a viable proposal to its creditors, and in order to continue assisting the Proposal Trustee with implementing the sales and investment solicitation process approved by this Court (the "SISP").
- 9. The SISP commenced on or about March 7, 2022. The Phase I Bid Deadline for Potential Bidders to submit letters of intent in order to become Qualified Bidders (each as defined in the SISP) was May 6, 2022.
- 10. It is anticipated that Phase 2 of the SISP will conclude on June 28, 2022.
- 11. The Third Stay Extension is appropriate for, among others, the following reasons:
 - (a) Vertex has acted, and continues to act in good faith and with due diligence;
 - (b) Vertex will likely be able to make a viable proposal if the Third Stay Extension is granted; and

- (c) no creditor will be materially prejudiced by the requested Third Stay Extension.
- 12. The Proposal Trustee and HSBC support the Third Stay Extension.
- 13. Such further and other grounds as counsel may advise and this Honourable Court may permit.

- 14. Affidavit No. 3 of Craig Flint sworn May 16, 2022.
- 15. Brief of Vertex, to be filed.
- 16. Report of Proposal Trustee, to be filed.
- 17. Such further and other materials as counsel may advise and this Honourable Court may permit.

- 18. The Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act, RSC 1985, c B-3, as amended; and
- 19. Such further and other Acts and Regulations as counsel may advise and that this Honourable Court may permit.
