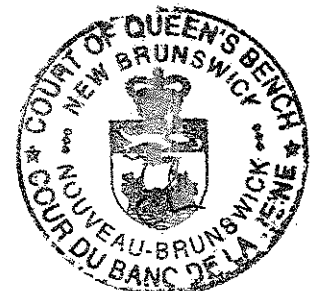
**IN THE MATTER OF** the proposal of Zio's Pizza

**AND UPON** hearing from counsel for the Applicant;

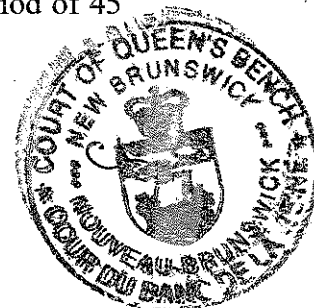
**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

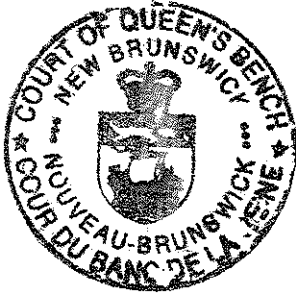
**EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PROPOSAL**
