THIS COURT ORDERS that upon completion of the BMO Settlement, as defined in paragraph 28 of the Report along with payment of any outstanding fees of the Receiver and its counsel and upon the Receiver filing a certificate certifying that it has completed the other activities described in the Report, the Receiver shall be discharged as Receiver of the undertaking, property and assets of the Debtor, provided however that notwithstanding its discharge herein (a) the Receiver shall remain Receiver for the performance of such incidental duties as may be required to complete the administration of the receivership herein, and (b) the Receiver shall continue to have the benefit of the provisions of all Orders made in this proceeding, including all approvals, protections and stays of proceedings in favour of MNP Ltd. in its capacity as Receiver.
- 4. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that MNP Ltd. is hereby released and discharged from any and all liability that MNP Ltd. now has or may hereafter have by reason of, or in any way arising out of, the acts or omissions of MNP Ltd. while acting in its capacity as Receiver herein, save and except for any gross negligence or wilful misconduct on the Receiver's part. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, MNP Ltd. is hereby forever released and discharged from any and all liability relating to matters that were raised, or which could have been raised, in the within receivership proceedings, save and except for any gross negligence or wilful misconduct on the Receiver's part.
