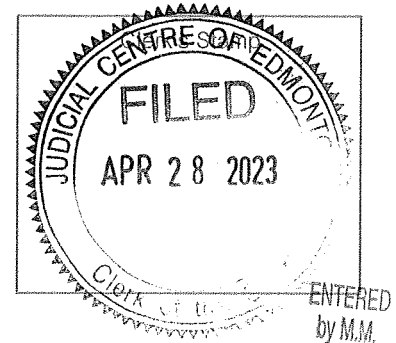

UPON THE APPLICATION by MNP Ltd. in its capacity as the Court-appointed Receiver and Manager (the "Receiver") of the undertakings, property and assets of A.B.C. Afterschool Ltd. (the "Company") for orders approving the sale transaction, approving the fees and disbursements of the Receiver and its legal counsel, discharging the Receiver and other ancillary relief; AND UPON HAVING READ the Receivership Order dated May 14, 2020 (the "Receivership Order"), the Second Report, Confidential Addendum to the Second Report and the Affidavit of Service; AND UPON HEARING the submissions of counsel for the Receiver, and any other parties appearing; **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:**

#### **REVIVAL OF THE COMPANY**

1. Pursuant to Section 210 of the *Business Corporations Act* (Alberta), the Company is hereby revived for the limited purpose of continuing and concluding this Receivership Action immediately upon providing a certified copy of this Order with the Registrar of Corporate Registry.

2. The Receiver is hereby relieved of any obligation to further file the Corporations' delinquent and future annual returns; however the Receiver is hereby directed to send to the Registrar, once a year, a yearly report as to the status of the Receivership until the Receivership is concluded, and the Receiver is further hereby directed to send to the Registrar written notice that the Receivership is completed upon the Receiver's discharge becoming effective (the "Discharge Notice").
3. Upon the receipt of the Discharge Notice by the Registrar, the Company shall forthwith be struck from the Corporate Registry.

#### **TEMPORARY SEALING OF THE CONFIDENTIAL ADDENDUM**

4. The Confidential Addendum to the Second Report of the Receiver shall be temporarily sealed on the Court file until further Order of this Court, notwithstanding Division 4 of Part 6 of the *Alberta Rules of Court*.
5. The Clerk of this Honourable Court shall temporarily file the Confidential Addendum to the Second Report of the Receiver in a sealed envelope until June 30, 2023, unless otherwise extended by further Order of the Court, that sets out the style of cause of these proceedings and states that:

THIS ENVELOPE CONTAINS CONFIDENTIAL MATERIALS FILED BY MNP LTD., IN ITS CAPACITY AS COURT-APPOINTED RECEIVER OF A.B.C. AFTERSCHOOL LTD. THE CONFIDENTIAL MATERIALS ARE SEALED UNTIL JUNE 30, 2023, UNLESS OTHERWISE EXTENDED BY FURTHER ORDER OF THE COURT, PURSUANT TO AN ORDER ISSUED BY JUSTICE NEILSON ON APRIL 28, 2023.

6. The Receiver shall be at liberty to apply, on notice, to extend the expiry of the herein temporary sealing date beyond June 30, 2023.

#### **SERVICE**


7. Service of notice of this application and supporting materials is hereby declared to be good and sufficient, no other person is required to have been served with notice of this application and time for service of this application is abridged to that actually given.
8. Service of this Order shall be deemed good and sufficient by:
  - (a) Serving the same on:

    - (ii) any other person served with notice of the application for this Order;

- (iii) any other parties attending or represented at the application for this Order;
