## AFFIDAVIT OF WESLEY ROITMAN

Sworn on April 24, 2020

I, WESLEY ROITMAN, of the City of Toronto, in the Province of Ontario, SWEAR AND SAY THAT:

- I am Managing General Partner of the Plaintiff, Romspen Investment Corporation, which is the manager and administrative agent for the Plaintiff, Romspen Mortgage Limited Partnership ("RMLP", and collectively, "Romspen"). As such, I have personal knowledge of the matters hereinafter deposed to, except where stated to be based on information and belief, and where so stated I verily believe the same to be true.
- 2. This Affidavit has been sworn during the COVID-19 pandemic. Accordingly, in an effort to streamline the amount of paper being produced, I have intentionally only appended critical documents as exhibits. To the extent that this Honourable Court or any of the parties hereto require copies of any other documents referenced herein, those will be provided by email upon request.



- 3. I have previously sworn affidavits in these proceedings on March 30, 2020 (the "First Affidavit"), on April 1, 2020 and on April 17, 2020. Unless otherwise indicated, capitalised terms used herein have the meanings given to them in my First Affidavit.
- 4. I make this Affidavit in support of the relief sought in the Application of Romspen, re: Extension of Interim Monitor (the "Application"), and for no other purpose.

## **Appointment of Interim Monitor**

- 5. On April 2, 2020, the Honourable Associate Chief Justice K.G. Nielsen pronounced an Order (the "Interim Monitor Order") entitling Romspen to appoint an interim monitor (the "Interim Monitor"), of its choice, to monitor the business and operations of GP, LP, Eco-Industrial, Absolute Energy, Absolute Environmental (collectively, the "Corporate Respondents").
- 6. In particular, I understand that the Interim Monitor Order provides, among other things, that:
  - (a) management of the Corporate Respondents shall cooperate and provide information to the Interim Monitor;
  - (b) the Interim Monitor shall have full transparency of all the Corporate Respondents' business operations and assets, including the ability to observe the operations of the Corporate Respondents;
  - (c) the Interim Monitor shall have access to all the business records of the Corporate Respondents;
  - (d) the Interim Monitor shall be entitled to be physically present at the business premises of the Corporate Respondents; and
  - (e) the Interim Monitor Order shall remain in place for a period of 30 days unless varied by this Honourable Court.
- 7. Given the urgent need to preserve and monitor the property of the Corporate Respondents, in respect of which Romspen has first-ranking security interests, Romspen appointed MNP Ltd. ("MNP") as Interim Monitor without delay on April 3, 2020.

## Requests for Information and Access to the Corporate Respondents

8. On April 3, 2020, counsel to Romspen requested that the Corporate Respondents advise who the Interim Monitor should use as its contact person for gaining access to the business premises, and for collecting information relevant to its analysis.

- 9. I am advised that counsel to Romspen repeated such requests by email of April 6, 2020 and again by email of April 7, 2020. In this correspondence, counsel to Romspen emphasized the urgent need for the contact name to be provided to the Interim Monitor.
- 10. Despite these repeated requests, the Corporate Respondents did not provide a contact person for the Interim Monitor until April 8, 2020, when they advised that Gary Vandepol, the President of Absolute Environmental, would be the contact person. At the same time, counsel to the Corporate Respondents also advised that Mr. Vandepol was currently on the island of Aruba, and that it was "unclear" when he would be able to return to Canada.
- 11. True copies of the correspondence between Romspen's counsel and counsel to the Corporate Respondents, between April 3 and 8, 2020, discussing the contact person for the Interim Monitor are attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- 12. Once Romspen learned that Mr. Vandepol would be the contact point, Romspen advised the Interim Monitor of the same, and the Interim Monitor immediately emailed a preliminary information request (the "Information Request") to Mr. Vandepol on April 8, 2020.
- 13. However, I understand that the Interim Monitor received no substantive response to the Information Request from Mr. Vandepol until late on April 17, 2020. Specifically, I understand that Mr. Vandepol provided the Interim Monitor only a few bank statements on April 17, 2020, which were incomplete and did not in any event address all of the Information Request.
- I have reviewed a letter of the Interim Monitor's counsel dated April 20, 2020, and do verily believe that the delays and lack of cooperation on the part of Mr. Vandepol now means that the Interim Monitor will be unable to undertake a fulsome monitoring, review and analysis of the Corporate Respondents' business by the current expiry of the Interim Monitor Order on May 2, 2020. A true copy of the letter of the Interim Monitor's counsel, dated April 20, 2020, is attached hereto as Exhibit "B".
- 15. Romspen will be materially prejudiced if the Interim Monitor is prevented from completing its analysis and reporting.

## Litigation Steps for Receivership Application

16. I am further advised by my counsel that the Interim Monitor Order contemplates that Romspen will be entitled to question Mr. Vandepol on an affidavit he swore on April 1, 2020 (the "Vandepol Affidavit"). Mr. Vandepol swore the Vandepol Affidavit in opposition to Romspen's Application for Appointment of a Receiver filed on March 31, 2020 (the "Receivership Application").



- 17. In addition to questioning on the Vandepol Affidavit, Romspen may wish to examine Mr. Vandepol in respect of information provided to the Interim Monitor. That determination has not yet been made as the Corporate Respondents have substantively failed to comply with the Interim Monitor's Information Request. Accordingly, any questioning of Mr. Vandepol at this stage would be preliminary and incomplete.
- 18. I do verily believe that the questioning of Mr. Vanderpol should occur before the Interim Monitor Order expires and before this Honourable Court determines the Receivership Application.
- 19. Yet, in the present circumstances, I understand that Romspen's questioning of Mr. Vandepol is unlikely to occur before, at the very earliest, April 27, 2020, with corresponding delays to the hearing for the Receivership Application.
- 20. Simply put, I am seriously concerned that the Interim Monitor Order will expire before this Honourable Court determines the Receivership Application. As detailed in my First Affidavit, the amount owing to Romspen by the Respondents exceeds USD \$96 million, which is secured by the property of the Corporate Respondents. Thus, Romspen may be materially prejudiced if the property of the Corporate Respondents is not monitored until the Receivership Application is determined.
- 21. Romspen has made its affiants available for questioning in a timely manner. Specifically, I was questioned on my prior affidavits on April 21, 2020. Likewise, Karin Duemler was questioned on her affidavits on April 21, 2020. The Corporate Respondents' counsel made numerous undertaking requests during our questioning of April 21, 2020, which we will seek to address as soon as practicable.

### Extension of Interim Monitor Order

- 22. In light of the foregoing, I do verily believe that it is just, equitable and necessary for MNP's appointment as Interim Monitor to be extended for at least 60 days. Specifically, an extension is necessary:
  - (a) for the Corporate Respondents to respond to the Information Request of the Interim Monitor;
  - (b) to enable the Interim Monitor to review and analyse the information received from the Corporate Respondents, and provide Romspen and this Honourable Court with a report of the same; and
  - (c) to enable the litigation steps for the Receivership Application to be completed and for the Receivership Application to be heard.

As of the date hereof, I understand that Mr. Vandepol remains in Aruba and there is no timeline for his return to Canada. I am further advised by my counsel that it is doubtful that Mr. Vandepol has access to adequate internet and other technology required for his questioning to be conducted remotely while he is in Aruba. Thus, I believe an extension of the Interim Monitor Order of at least 60 days is appropriate.

## Conclusion

- 24. This Affidavit was sworn using video technology due to the COVID-19 pandemic. I did not swear this Affidavit in the physical presence of the Commissioner for Oaths.
- 25. In advance of swearing this Affidavit, I have shown the Commissioner for Oaths the front and back of my current government-issued photo identification.
- 26. I do verily believe that this Affidavit has been sworn in compliance with NPP#2020-02 issued by the Court of Queen's Bench on March 25, 2020.
- 27. I make this Affidavit in support of the relief sought in the Application and for no other purpose. I am authorized to swear this Affidavit on behalf of Romspen.

Good afternoon Kevin,

I have reviewed the form of Order that you previously circulated. I have also incorporated the comments that Mr Payne previously shared with me. The comments / proposed revisions appear in red in the attached Order.

My comments can be summarized as follows:

- the Romspen Order defined Mr White, Absolute Environmental, etc as "the debtors". That in my view is an unfair term as it has never been established that they owe any money to Romspen. As a result, I took out the word debtors and replaced it with the more neutral term "Respondents";
- I have modified the language which partially vacates the October 25, 2019 stay of Mr Justice Gill;
- I have deleted the reference to Section 47 from Paragraph 5 of the Order. Justice Nielsen certainly made reference to Section 47 of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act during the hearing but Section 47 outlines the powers of an Interim Receiver. If I understand your comments from earlier today, you are of the view that the Monitor will have the powers that are outlined in Section 47 of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act. That in my view is incorrect as if Justice Nielsen intended the Monitor to have the powers of an Interim Receiver that are outlined in Section 47, he would have appointed an Interim Receiver. His Lordship, however, specifically declined to do that.

Romspen Mortgage Limited Partnership and Romspen Investment Corporation (collectively "Romspen") v. Absolute Energy Resources Inc. et al, Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta Action No. 2003-06728 (the "Action")

As you are aware, we are counsel to MNP Ltd. in its capacity as Interim Monitor (the "Interim Monitor"), having been engaged to act in such capacity by Romspen pursuant to the April 2, 2020 Order (the "Order") of Associate Chief Justice K. G. Nielsen granted in the Action. While we understand that a copy of the Order arising from Justice Nielsen's April 2, 2020 Order has not yet been filed with the Court, we understand that on April 2, 2020 Justice Nielsen directed (amongst other things) that:

- The Interim Monitor was to monitor the business operations of Lot 11 GP Ltd., Lot 11 Limited Partnership, Eco-Industrial Business Park Inc., Absolute Energy Resources Inc., Absolute Environmental Waste Management Inc. and Daniel Alexander White (collectively the "Debtors")
- Management of the Debtors was directed to cooperate and provide information to the Interim Monitor such that the Interim Monitor would have full transparency of all the Debtors' business operations and assets,
- The Interim Monitor was to have access to all the business records of the Debtors, and
- The Order was to expire within 30 days, subject to further order of the Court.

We write to update you on the Interim Monitor's efforts and steps taken since the granting of the Order on April 2.

- 1. The Interim Receiver was first provided with contact information for an individual at the Debtors on April 8 when the Debtors' counsel advised by email that the appropriate contact person would be a Gary Vandepol, and provided Mr. Vandepol's contact information. Enclosed is a copy of an April 8 email from the Debtor's counsel to your office, and from your office to the Interim Monitor, in this regard.
- 2. That same day, the Interim Monitor sent Mr. Vandepol an email with a preliminary information request (the "Information Request") for the information and documents that the Interim Monitor required from the Debtors. Enclosed is a copy of the Interim Monitor's April 8 email with the Information Request to Mr. Vandepol.
- 3. Later that same day the Interim Monitor received an email from Mr. Vandepol in response to the Interim Monitor's earlier email, advising (amongst other things) that: (a) he was limited in how quickly he would be able to provide the Interim Monitor with the information listed in the Information Request, (b) he wanted a copy of the Order, and (c) he wanted to see a copy of the Interim Monitor's scope of work. A copy of that April 8 email from Mr. Vandepol is enclosed with this letter.
- 4. The Interim Monitor responded to this email (and the various requests) from Mr. Vandepol by email dated April 8. A copy of the Interim Monitor's email is enclosed with this letter.
- 5. On April 13 the Interim Monitor had not received any of the information listed in the Information Request, and so sent an email to Mr. Vandepol asking when that information would be received. On that same day Mr. Vandepol responded saying that he has "been working on it diligently" and that the Interim Monitor "should start getting info . . . starting tomorrow." A copy of this April 13 email exchange is enclosed with this letter.
- 6. As at April 16 the Interim Monitor still had not received any of the information which had been requested on April 8. The Interim Monitor therefore sent a follow-up email to Mr. Vandepol on April 16, and a copy of that email is enclosed with this letter.
- 7. At 6:24 p.m. on April 17 the Interim Monitor received an email from Mr. Vandepol attaching various bank statements. A copy of that email is enclosed with this letter. Having reviewed the bank statements which were attached to this letter, the Interim Monitor determined that they were:

- a. CIBC bank statements for Absolute Environmental Waste Management Inc. from June 2018 to April 2020, and
- b. CIBC bank statements for Eco-Industrial Business Park Inc. from April 2018 to April 2020.

As such, this represents only a small portion of the information which had been requested by the Interim Monitor in the Information Request.

- 8. On April 18, the Interim Monitor replied to Mr. Vandepol's April 17 email, asking some preliminary questions with respect to the bank statements that had been provided on April 17. A copy of that email is enclosed with this letter. As of the writing of this letter, no response has been received in response to the Interim Monitor's April 18 email.
- 9. As of the writing of this letter, the Interim Monitor has not had any further response from Mr. Vandepol and has not received any of the additional information which had been requested by the Interim Monitor in the April 8 Information Request beyond the bank statements described above. The bank statements which have been provided fall well short of the information required by the Monitor to permit it to undertake a fulsome monitoring of the Debtors' business operations. As a result, the Interim Monitor now finds itself in a position where even if the balance of the information in the Information Request were provided immediately it is unlikely that the Interim Monitor would have enough time to fully review and analyze such information, have any follow-up questions answered, and be able to provide its report to Romspen before the 30 day expiry of the Order.

Gary,

Thanks for your email response. With respect to the various matters you raise in your email, I can advise as follows:

- Firstly, I am unable to provide you with a filed copy of the Order. As you may be aware, while the Order was granted by Associate Chief Justice Neilsen on April 2, the document evidencing the Order that has been granted is still in the process of being finalized by counsel. Moreover, there will no doubt be a delay in having the document filed with the Court in light of the reduced Court operations at the moment due to COVID-19 responses. Nevertheless, the Order is valid and effective from its pronouncement on April 2. Amongst other things, the Order permits Romspen to appoint an Interim Monitor. As noted in my earlier email, Romspen has engaged MNP Ltd. ("MNP", or the "Monitor") for this purpose;
- Secondly, to the extent you wish to understand your obligations under the April 2
  Order of A.C.J. Neilsen, we would suggest that you consult with your legal
  counsel. I am afraid that the Monitor is unable to assist you in this regard;
- Thirdly, as the engagement letter is a matter between Romspen and MNP I am afraid I am not in a position to share a copy of the engagement letter with you;
- Fourthly, any scope of work that may be set out in the engagement letter is between Romspen and MNP. The Monitor has requested the information set out in the preliminary information request which was attached to my earlier email. It is the Monitor's understanding that the April 2 Order granted by Justice Neilsen compels you and all other personnel to cooperate with the Interim Monitor's information requests and to give the Monitor access to all business records. We therefore look forward to receiving such information as soon as possible. While we appreciate that you may be out of the country, we would expect that much of this can be handled remotely, and also expect that there are personnel in Alberta who can assist with these requests. Since the original appointment of the Monitor is for 30 days (subject to further Court Order) we look forward to your cooperation and the cooperation of all personnel who are present in Alberta.
- Finally, thank you for your invitation for the Monitor to attend the Hayter Road location in Edmonton. Are you able to advise if this is "head office" and if some or all of the records we are seeking are kept at that location? It may not be necessary for the Monitor to visit this location if the information and documents that have been requested are provided. But if it would assist for the Monitor to visit this location please advise, and please provide us with the contact information for senior management who may be in charge of the Hayter Road

location for the Monitor to contact if it becomes necessary to organize such a visit.
