Further to our Notices to the Customers, dated March 11 and March 25, 2020, MNP Ltd. (“MNP” or the “Receiver”), in its capacity as the receiver and manager of Old Mill Marina (Kawagama) Ltd. (“Old Mill”), is providing periodic updates to the customers of Old Mill.

**Spring Launch and Slip Rentals**

Based on current ice depths and weather forecasts, we’re advised that the ice could be out of the lake by the last week of April. As previously advised, we are prioritizing the launching of boats and slip rentals for those with cottages that are water access only. We would like to ensure that the list provided to us of water access cottagers is as accurate as possible. Accordingly, we’re asking all water access only cottagers to email us at [oldmillmarina@mnp.ca](mailto:oldmillmarina@mnp.ca) to confirm that you require your boat to be launched for accessing your cottage. Please ensure the subject line of the email reads “**Water Access Cottager**”.

You can appreciate that these are remarkably uncertain times and the priority is the health and safety of all parties involved whether that be employees, customers or others. As a result, our plans for reopening Old Mill and the spring launch program are subject to change.
