- 1. The Applicant, MNP Ltd., in its capacity as receiver and manager (the "Receiver") of Seama Shalchi-Moghaddam Professional Corporation (the "Debtor") respectfully seeks an Order substantially in the form attached hereto as Schedule "A" for, *inter alia*:
 - (a) abridging the time for service of this Application and the supporting materials, as necessary, and deeming service thereof to be good and sufficient;
 - (b) approving the listing agreement between Henry Schein Tier Three Brokerage Ltd. ("Henry Schein") and the Receiver to be executed subject to approval of this Honourable Court (the "Listing Agreement");
 - (c) approving the activities of the Receiver as outlined in the First Report of the Receiver dated October 17, 2022;
 - (d) sealing the Confidential First Report of the Receiver dated October 17, 2022; and
 - (e) such further and other relief as counsel may request and this Honourable Court may deem appropriate in the circumstances.

Grounds for making this Application

- 2. On September 2, 2022, pursuant to the Order of this Honourable Court, MNP Ltd. was appointed as receiver and manager of the property, assets and undertaking of the Debtor (the "Receivership Order").
- 3. Pursuant to section 3(I) and (m) of the Receivership Order, the Receiver is authorized to, among other things, market any or all of the property of the Debtor and sell the property or any parts thereof with the approval of this Honourable Court.
- 4. It is the Receiver's position that the Listing Agreement obtained by Henry Schein is reasonable and will provide for sufficient market exposure such that the value of the property of the Debtor will be maximized.
- 5. The information in the listing proposals obtained by the Receiver contains sensitive financial information regarding the Property of the Debtor. The temporary sealing of this information until a transaction closes is necessary, to ensure that the marketing of the Property is not negatively impacted to the detriment of the Debtor's stakeholders. The salutary effects of temporarily sealing this information outweighs any deleterious effects. The Receiver is prepared to release this information, as deemed appropriate, subject to the execution of a confidentiality undertaking by the party requesting access to this information.

6. The Receiver has acted reasonably and in good faith during the administration of the receivership and its action, conduct and activities should be approved.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:

1. Service of the Notice of Application for this Order is hereby validated and deemed good and sufficient, this application is properly returnable today, and no person other than those persons served is entitled to service of the Notice of Application.

APPROVAL OF LISTING AGREEMENT

2. A listing agreement between Henry Schein Tier Three Brokerage Ltd. and the Receiver, substantially in the form attached as Schedule 2 to the First Report (the "Listing Agreement") is hereby approved and execution of the Listing Agreement by the Receiver is hereby authorized and approved, with such minor amendments as the Receiver may deem necessary. The Receiver is hereby authorized and directed to take such additional steps and execute such additional documents as may be necessary or desirable for completion of the terms contemplated by the Listing Agreement.

SEALING ORDER

- 3. The Clerk of the Court is hereby directed to seal the Confidential First Report, pursuant to paragraph 4 of this Order.
- 4. The Confidential First Report detailing proposals received by the Receiver in respect of the proposed sale of the property, assets and undertaking of the Debtor (the "**Property**"), shall be sealed on the Court file, notwithstanding Division 4 of Part 6 of the *Alberta Rules of Court* until the filing of the Receiver's Certificate confirming that the sale of the Property has been completed. The Clerk of this Honourable Court shall file the Confidential First Report in a sealed envelope that sets out the style of cause of these proceedings and states:
